	116. TUTORIAL INSTRUCTION
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that some students may require special help beyond the regular classroom program.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>Wherever possible within the working day, each teaching staff member shall assist assigned students in the remediation of individual learning difficulties.</p> <p>In certain cases where extra help is desirable and the parents request such assistance, the building principal or designee may recommend that the parents secure tutorial services for the student from a list of available tutors maintained by the school.</p> <p>This determination will be made through joint consultation of the classroom teacher, parent and the appropriate representative of the administration.</p>
3. Guidelines  Title 22 Sec. 11.22	<p><u>Excusal From School</u></p> <p>Upon the written request of the parent, a student may be excused during school hours for tutoring in a field not offered in the district's curricula, if such an excusal does not interfere with the student's regular program of studies.</p> <p>The tutor's qualifications must be approved by the Superintendent.</p> <p>The district may establish reasonable conditions for excusal of a student for such tutoring.</p>
