Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of remedial and enrichment instruction at the elementary and jr/sr high school level for resident students of this district and other students the Board may admit.</p> <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Employ teaching and administrative staff. 2. Provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment. 3. Utilize schools or other facilities as required. 4. Provide necessary custodial services.

Title 22 Sec. 4.41	Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.

Guidelines	<p>Students eligible for the district's summer school program shall include resident students who are eligible for regular attendance in district schools and nonresident students.</p> <p>Tuition fees established by the Board shall be charged to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resident students. 2. Nonresident students and shall cover all expenses of the summer school program, except for start-up costs which the Board may provide in its annual budget. <p>With regard to transportation, the Board does not accept responsibility for any student.</p>

Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>School Code 502, 1901, 1903, 1906</p> <p>PA Code Title 22 Sec. 4.41</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Planning the summer school curriculum.2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.3. Assigning students and staff.4. Evaluating and reporting on student progress.5. Utilizing facilities.6. Developing and enforcing rules for student behavior. <p>Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.</p>
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
