	214. CLASS RANK	
1. Purpose	The Board acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing numerical averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents and others of their relative academic placement among their peers under relatively similar circumstances.	
2. Authority	The Board authorizes a system of class ranking for all students in grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 which shall be computed by the final numberical average in all subjects for which credit is awarded.	
	A student's numerical average and rank in class shall be entered on his/her record and shall be subject to the Board's policy on release of student records. Rank in class shall be entered on students' records and on all transcripts where they will be available for review by authorized persons.	P.G. 216
3. Delegation of Responsibility	To implement this policy, the principals shall develop procedures for the computation of numerical averages and the assignment of rank in class. A statement of the methods for such computation and assignment will be made available for those to whom a student's numerical average or rank in class is released.	
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
