STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING</p> <p>The Board believes that students should participate in the governance of school activities at levels appropriate to their ages and competencies because students should have a part in determining activities that affect their lives. As an institution fundamental to the operation of a democratic society, the schools should strive to exemplify the democratic ideal of citizen participation in decision-making. Students are a valuable resource whose contributions can aid and benefit the programs of the schools, and as part of their educational development, students should be provided experiences and decision-making roles to prepare them for the future.</p> <p>The Board directs that students be invited to participate in activities appropriate to their maturity and competency, leading to administrative decision-making in:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student Code of Conduct. 2. Curriculum planning. <p>Suggestions for improvement may be offered by any student, provided they are of a constructive nature and contribute toward the realization of the district's educational goals.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide for submission, consideration, and response to constructive student suggestions. 2. Designate the manner by which students shall be selected for participation in school matters.
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
