Guide	238. USE OF BEEPERS/PAGING DEVICES BY STUDENTS	Reference
1. Purpose	<p>The use of electronic devices by School District personnel/employees where supportive of the general welfare and the instructional program of the school is endorsed. The use of beepers by students has been found not only disruptive but, in many instances, contributory to illegal purposes. This policy shall serve notice to all concerned that use of beepers by students on school premises is prohibited unless authorized by the principal.</p>	1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9
2. Authority	<p>The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent to develop and enforce regulations to prohibit use of beepers by students. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent may delegate responsibility for the enforcement and reporting the progress of this policy to appropriate School District officials.</p> <p>Each principal shall inform the students of this policy by general announcement, by inclusion in the school's handbook.</p>	Pol. 233
