	414. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION	
1. <u>Purpose</u>	In order to certify the fitness of employes to discharge efficiently the duties which they will be performing and to protect the health of students from the transmission of communicable diseases, physical examinations of all professional employes will be required prior to employment.	
2. <u>Definition</u>	For purposes of this policy, a "physical examina- tion" shall mean a general examination by a licensed physician.	
3. <u>Guidelines</u>	All candidates for employment, prior to being placed on the rolls of the district, shall undergo a medical examination as required by law, the expense of which shall be borne by the candidate.	
	The Board requires that all employes undergo a tuberculosis examination upon initial employment in accordance with the regulations of the Advisory Health Board which shall be provided by the district.	
	The results of all required medical examinations shall be made known to the Superintendent on a confidential basis, discussed with the employe, and made a part of the employe's record. In the event of an unsatisfactory report, the Superintendent shall follow Board policy relating to Disqualification By Reason Of Health, No. 415.	
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
