	519. OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES	
1. <u>Purpose</u>	The Board recognizes that employes must enjoy private lives and may associate with others outside of school for political, economic, religious, or cultural or personal reasons. The Board and its supervisory staff, however, have a responsibility to evaluate employes in terms of their faithfulness to, and effectiveness in discharging school duties and responsibilities. Therefore, when non-school activities threaten an employe's effectiveness within the school system, the Board reserves the right to evaluate the impact of such activities upon the employe's responsibilities to the district.	
2. <u>Delegation</u> of <u>Responsi-</u> bility	The Board directs the Business Manager/Board Secretary to promulgate guidelines so that classified employes may avoid situations in which their personal interests, activities, and associations may conflict with the interests of the district.	
3. <u>Guidelines</u>	The following are provided for the guidance of classified employes:	
	 Do not use school property or school time to solicit or accept customers for private enter- prises. 	
	 Do not use job time for outside activities when there is no valid reason to be excused from as- signed duties. 	
	 Do not engage in political activities during as- signed hours of employment. 	
	 Refrain from expressions regarding district poli- cies or procedures that would disrupt harmony among co-workers or interfere with the maintenance of discipline by school officials. 	
	 Refrain from making public statements about private associations or interests if such remarks are like- ly to violate community standards of propriety. page 1/1
