## 701. FACILITIES PLANNING

### Purpose

The Board shall engage in short-term and long-term facilities planning in order to meet the ongoing needs of the District's educational programs and operations, in accordance with the Strategic Plan. The input of a diverse group of stakeholders is an important and valued part of this process.

### Authority

The Board of School Directors shall maintain enrollment data and other pertinent information, as required by law, which should be used as a consideration in planning improvements.

### Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for leading the District's efforts regarding short-term and long-term facilities planning and analysis.

In order to inform the Board of the status of existing District facilities and the future needs of the District, the Superintendent or designee shall prepare a written description of existing physical facilities and shall annually prepare and present to the Board:

1. A written description of existing facilities, including the current condition of the interior, exterior, and major systems, as well as a prioritized list of future maintenance, repairs, or upgrades;
2. Enrollment by grade level and building during the current school year, enrollment projections by grade level and building for the following school year, and a comparison of actual enrollment figures by grade level and building to the previously projected figures to detect early any changes in population trends; and
3. Recommendations, if any, regarding redistricting or grade configuration modifications based on current student population numbers and/or projected
