## 703. SANITARY MANAGEMENT

### **Purpose**

The Board recognizes that safeguarding the health and physical well-being of district students depends upon the cleanliness and proper sanitary conditions of the school buildings and grounds.

### **Authority**

The Board directs that a program of sanitary management shall be maintained in all district buildings and explained periodically to staff members. (1)

The Board directs that standards be maintained to meet requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor & Industry, and any local agency with jurisdiction.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

All district facilities shall be inspected regularly for cleanliness and proper sanitation by the Superintendent or designee.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop and supervise a program for the cleanliness and sanitary management of school buildings, school grounds and facilities, school grounds and school equipment pursuant to applicable law and regulations.

Cleanliness of each school building shall be the responsibility of the building principal in cooperation with the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds and building-level custodial staff.

Teachers shall be responsible for reporting any concerns about the condition of their classrooms to the administration.

Principals shall periodically inspect their facilities and report any conditions which may threaten the health, safety or welfare of occupants to the Superintendent or

designee.

**The Board shall be made aware of any material safety and health issues.**
