	<p style="text-align: center;">904. PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS</p>
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board welcomes the public at activities and events sponsored by the school district, but the Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve district facilities during such events.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 511, 775</p>	<p>The Board has the authority to prohibit at a school event the attendance of any individual whose conduct may constitute a disruption. The Board prohibits gambling and the possession and use of controlled substances, alcoholic beverages and weapons on school premises.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines P.L. 103-227 Act 168 of 1988</p>	<p>For purpose of this policy, tobacco includes electronic products, lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other smoking product or material and smokeless tobacco in any form. Electronic smoking products shall mean electronic products designed to deliver nicotine, flavor, and/or potentially harmful chemicals.</p> <p>The Board establishes the following regulations with respect to the conduct of school events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. With respect to smoking, there will be no smoking at any public function held in a school building, on school property, or in any vehicle owned, leased, or controlled by the district. 2. The District shall annually notify staff, parents/guardians and members of the public about the District's tobacco use policy by publishing such in handbooks, newsletters, posted notices, and other efficient methods. 3. A schedule of fees for all school events shall be approved by the Superintendent. 4. Senior citizens who are district residents and are sixty-two (62) years of age, may contact the Athletic Directors office to obtain a Senior Citizens pass for admittance without charge to all school events.

5. The Board will honor Senior Citizens passes from all districts that are members of conferences in which teams of this district compete and honor the Senior Citizens passes of this district.
6. Complimentary passes will be issued to:
 - a. Any district resident and/or employee who volunteers through the Athletic Directors office at three district sponsored events.
 - b. School Board members and their spouse.

Service Animals

Individuals with disabilities may be accompanied by their service animals while on district property for events that are open to the general public in accordance with Board policy and state and federal law and regulations.
